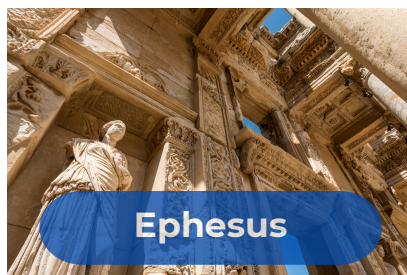
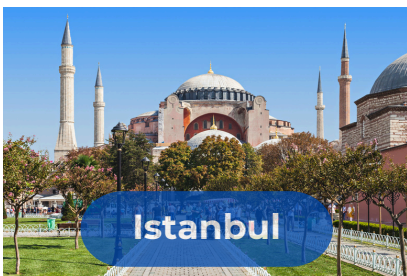

Continue your journey to Cappadocia, stopping to explore the Kaymakli Underground City, a refuge for early Christians. Dinner and overnight stay in Cappadocia.

Day 6: Discovering Cappadocia

Begin your day with an optional early morning hot air balloon ride over the stunning landscapes of Cappadocia. After breakfast, visit Derinkuyu Underground City, the Göreme Open Air Museum with its ancient rock-carved churches, Zelve Valley, and Pasabaglar. End the day in Avanos, a town famous for its pottery traditions. Dinner and overnight stay in Cappadocia.

Day 7: Cappadocia to Istanbul

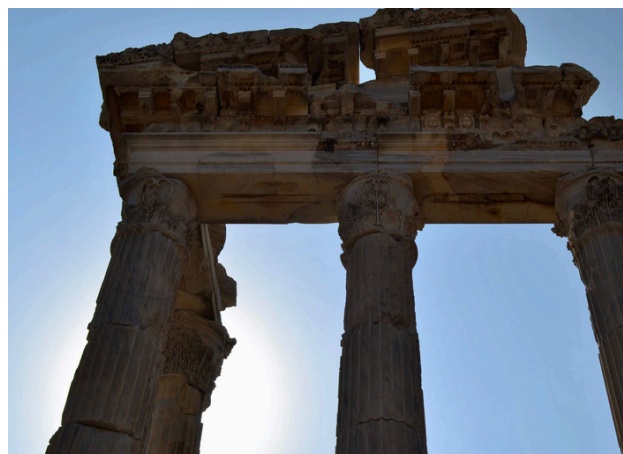

Continue to Philadelphia, the only church not censured, and see the ruins of a Byzantine basilica. Travel to Hierapolis, known for its hot springs and the martyrdom site of Apostle Philip. Visit Laodicea, seeing its ancient theatre, basilica remains, and other significant structures. Overnight in a thermal hotel in Hierapolis, where you can relax in the natural hot springs.



Day 4: Ephesus – Kusadasi

Drive to Ephesus, a major site among the seven churches. Visit the Basilica of St. John and the Ephesus Archaeological Museum. Walk through the ancient city, marvelling at the Baths of Scholastica, the Library of Celsus, the Temple of Hadrian, and the Great Theatre. Day 7: Hierapolis, Laodicea & Colossae

Explore the ancient city of Hierapolis, with its rich Christian history and famous hot springs. Visit the site where the Apostle Philip is believed to have been martyred. Continue to Laodicea, known for its lukewarm faith, where you can explore the extensive ruins, including the ancient theater, stadium, and sophisticated water systems. Nearby Colossae, once an important city, now lies in ruins, offering a quiet and contemplative end to the day's explorations.
